#### 23/90 APOLOGIES & DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

There were apologies from Cllrs Walker & Fletcher and the reasons were accepted. There were no declarations of interests.

#### 23/91 MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 2 MAY 2023

Minutes previously circulated and these were accepted.

## 23/92 PUBLIC FORUM

There were no members of the public present.

#### 23/93 CLERK'S REPORT

- a. The Land Registry had not cashed the cheque for the fees. It was agreed to research an alternative of registering Sandbed Dyke as village green.
- b. NYC Highways mirror and signs. Ann update was still awaited from NYC Highways on an alternative solution.
- c. Work had begun on installing the footbridge over the River Kyle.
- d. The cost of gritting Monk Green had not been received from NYC Highways.
- e. A wasp's nest found in the Avenue had been dealt with by NYC Pest Control.
- f. The Alne Cross signage had been dealt with. An accident had now damaged various signs.
- g. The Public Footpath diversion east of railway line was noted.
- h. A request for a Public Space Protection Order from a member of the public had been received. It was explained that this was not within the power of the Parish Council.
- i. The 50% grant to the village hall for a replacement door and windows had been given.
- j. The North Yorkshire Parish Charter had been published.
- k. The change of landlord of the recreational land from Hambleton DC to North Yorkshire Council was noted.
- I. A request from a resident to repair a fence at the Old Railway Yard had been received. The Parish Council do not own the fencing.
- m. The application to have the Bluebell Country Inn remain on the Community Asset Register was ongoing.

#### 23/94 HEDGEHOGS

a. It was agreed that, following a proposal by a resident, the Council purchase four hedgehog warning signs for the village. These would be erected subject to permission being received from NYC Highways.
